

Mission Trip Covenant & Code of Conduct

As we partner together in Christian service, we strive to create a safe, respectful environment where each individual can grow in faith. This covenant is designed to protect the testimony of the church and the individuals who are participating in the Heart and Hand mission trip. Also, the covenant is in place to promote unity and Christ centered fellowship within the group.

1. I will respect others.
2. I will be helpful during cleaning, pacing, and working times.
3. I will adhere to curfew, lights out, and “go to bed” times.
4. I will attend all meetings or other scheduled events.
5. I will follow the instructions given by the leadership of the mission trip.
6. I will not leave the working area or any other area without notifying the mission team leadership.
7. I will dress appropriately at all times:
 - a. Close-toed shoes must be worn on the worksites.
 - b. Undergarments should not be visible.
 - c. Clothing should be properly fastened.
 - d. T-shirts should be loose-fitting and unaltered.
 - e. No short, revealing, or tight shorts/skirts should be worn.
 - f. No revealing shirts should be worn.
 - g. If swimming is involved, women must wear a modest one-piece suite.
 - h. Men must wear t-shirts when not in the swimming area.
8. I will be respectful of other people, other groups, and leadership staff.
 - a. No offensive language or profanity.
 - b. No behavior that interferes with or threatens activities.
 - c. No behavior that threatens the health or safety of another person.
 - d. No pranks that harass another person or damage property.
