Popping the Pride Bubble

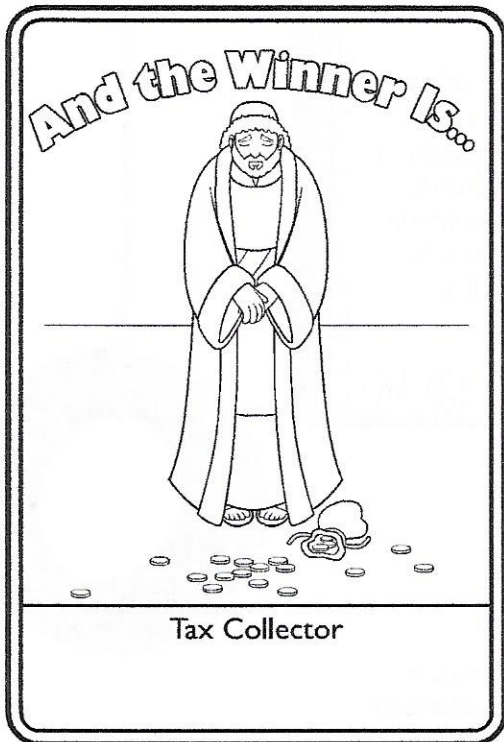


Prayer Challenge

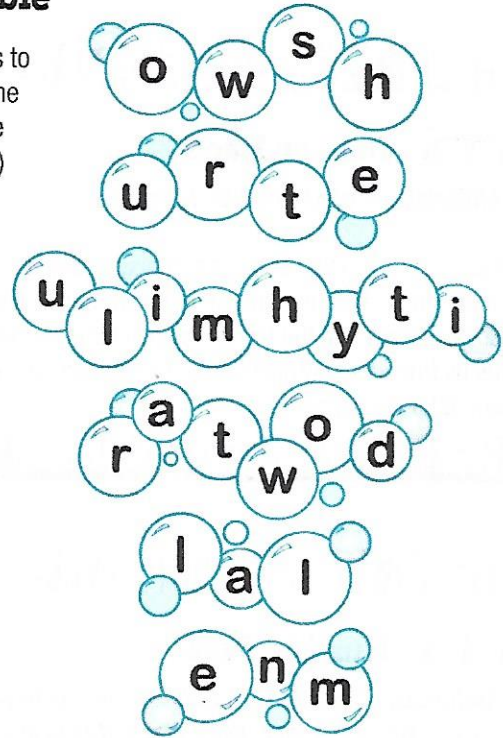
Trading Card
